Bright magenta/crimson in the glass with characters of juicy Doris plum, dark cherry and blueberry fruits with hints of baking spices, vanilla pod, citrus blossom, licorice, tobacco, earth and dark chocolate. Quite savoury and harmonious on the palate with almost a rocky, schisty feel to the fruit and powdery tannin array. Bright in line as always, spicy and pure as it bids farewell.

Spice-driven with a savoury undertone, giving aromas of Damson plums, wild blackberries, cassia bark and cloves. The palate is medium-bodied with fine tannins and bright acidity, showing notes of mocha, mulberry bush and dried herbs. Drink or hold. Screw cap.

Deep ruby colour. Mulberry and lavender bush aromatics. Crunchy blue fruits on entry, a lift of acidity early enlivens it then grainy tannins bring further tension. Some meaty and iodine notes add character to the palate and it carries a good length.
